Re: Visit to France 2017

We are pleased to inform you that, as a result of obtaining financial support from Cockermonth Round Table, we can reduce the cost of the trip to **£155**. As you have already paid a deposit of £50, that means the balance, due by **Thursday, 6th July**, is now **£105**. This will include all breakfasts from Friday to Sunday. The students will need to buy lunch on Thursday (food is provided on Bastille Day and we will have a packed lunch provided on Saturday) and an evening meal on Thursday and Saturday. Twenty-five euros should cover this. They will also need to buy breakfast on the outward ferry and lunch on the homeward ferry, (this can be paid for in sterling or euros) also an evening meal en route for home on Sunday evening. We will be stopping at service stations that have McDonald's and Burger King, so this shouldn't be too expensive.

Could we also remind you that a sleeping bag will be needed, as well as swimming gear? There is a pool on the campsite which has lifeguard surveillance. The weather should be warm, so light summer clothing, sun cream and a hat should be packed, as well as the usual toiletries and a towel.
