Ofsted Report

I am pleased to report that the Ofsted report following their recent visit to our school has now been published. While the school as a whole is Requires Improvement, we have been judged as 'Good' in Leadership and Management, and 'Good' in Personal Development, Behaviour and Welfare.

In particular, we are very proud that our students were particularly complimented on their behaviour and attitude - the inspector said, 'Pupils' behaviour is consistently good in lessons and around the school. They are respectful and try their best'.

The inspector also commented that, 'pupils' outcomes are improving as a result of clear leadership and improvements to teaching,' and 'the Executive Headteacher is inspiring improvements to teaching and learning and has developed productive links with other schools'. Furthermore, the Inspector commented that the Executive Headteacher is, 'ably supported by the Deputy Headteacher, who oversees the successful running of the school.'

You will see that the Ofsted have made some recommendations on what we need to do to improve further. Rest assured we already have plans in place to ensure these improvements are made as swiftly as possible, and we continue to work hard to ensure every student makes good progress and achieves the outcomes they deserve.
