Dear Parent/Carer

I am writing to inform you of a fantastic opportunity for your child to take part in swimming lessons as part of their PE curriculum. The lessons will start on the 4<sup>th</sup> January 2018 and end on the 8<sup>th</sup> February 2018. Lessons will be at Wigton Baths. We will be travelling in the school mini bus, leaving school at 9.00 on Thursday mornings and return to school at 12:45 in time for lunch.

Within these lessons pupils will be taught how to swim or to improve their swimming and will also have the opportunity to take part in a young lifeguard's course (CS only).

Pupils will need to bring a swimming costume/ shorts, a towel and goggles if needed. The cost for this opportunity is £1 per session, totalling £6 for the half term. This will need to be paid in advance of the lessons in order to secure a place, and therefore I would ask that the money and consent form need to be handed in to the school office before 4<sup>th</sup> December 2017.
