The Careers and Employability Programme at Cumbria Futures Federation: Our students are entitled to:

- explore the world of work and a wide range of post 16 opportunities through timetabled Careers lessons in both KS3 and KS4.
- recognise the crossover between the subjects they study in school and their relevance in wider world of work
- learn about qualifications, apprenticeships and opportunities as part of a careers programme across KS3 and KS4 which provides information on the full range of education and training options available.
- be informed about the opportunities on offer, including technical education and apprenticeships through
 options events, taster events, Careers assemblies, one to one INSPIRA interviews and Further Education
 Open Evenings.
- learn how to create CVs and make applications for the full range of academic and technical courses available.
- have opportunities for guidance interviews with a Careers Advisor and Further Education providers.
 Interviews will be made available through our Work Ready Programmes and whenever significant study or career choices are being made.
- develop employability skills (including CV, interview, application skills) and engage with local employers.
- Careers fairs Both Solway School and Beacon Hill School hold annual Careers Fairs where local representatives from Colleges, 6th Form and Apprenticeship Schemes meet and speak directly with our students enabling them to learn more about Further Education opportunities and have a real look for work, training or apprenticeship opportunities.
